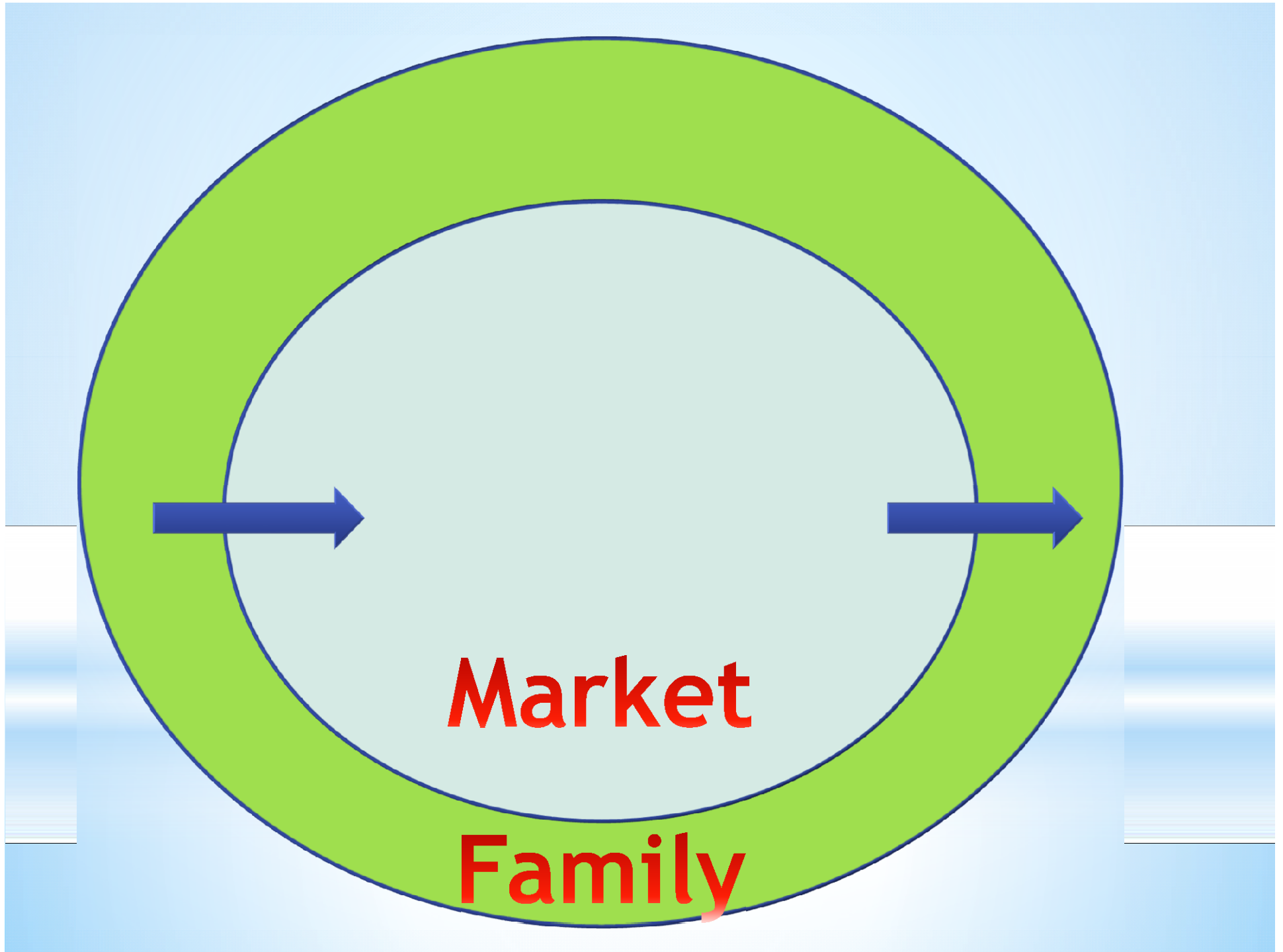

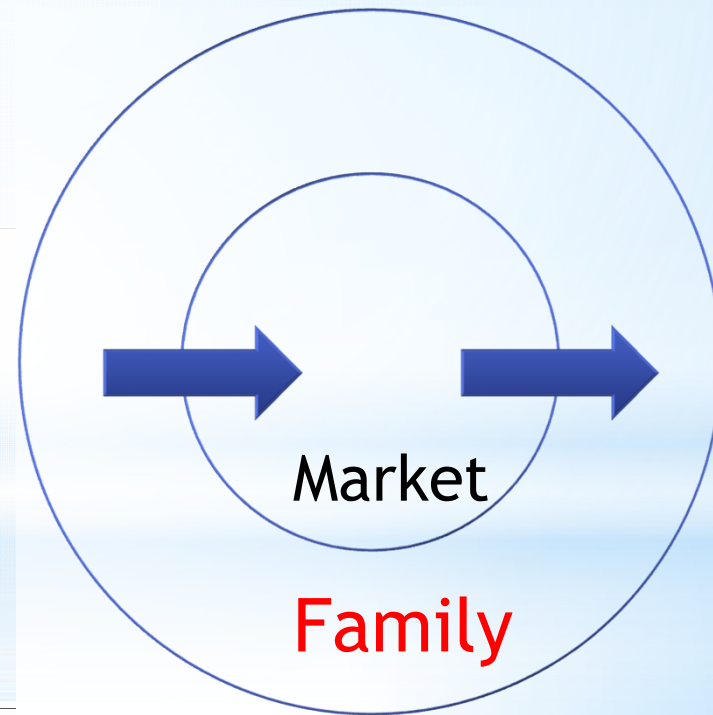




Flow of Material



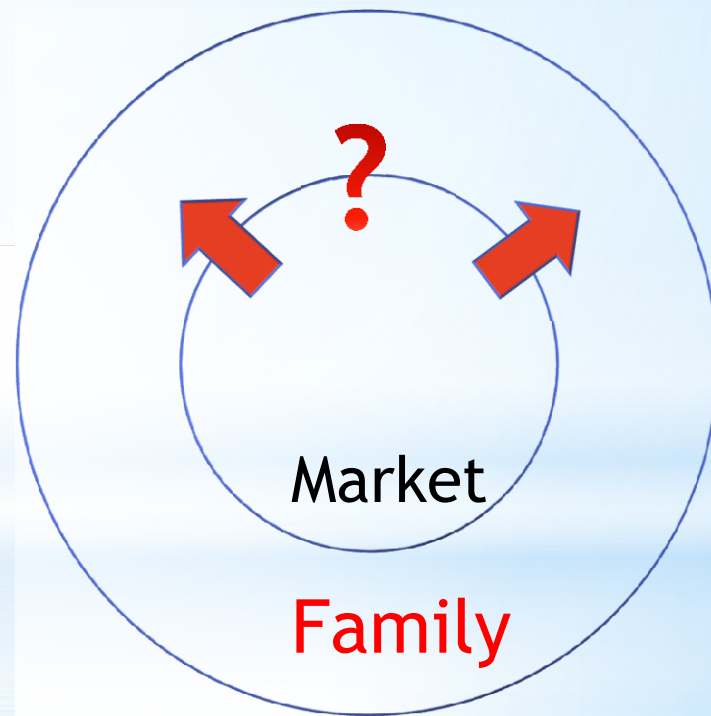
Flow of Human Capital (Labor Force)
